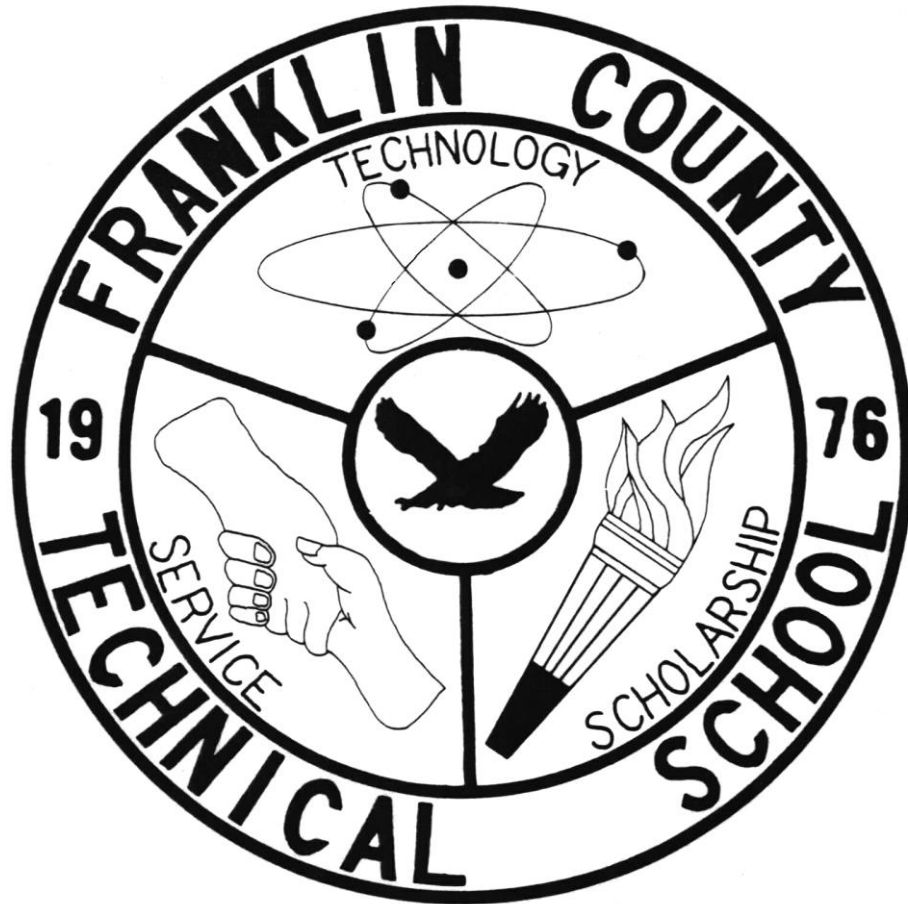

SUMMARY OF ADMISSIONS POLICY

A. The responsibility for admission of students is solely that of the Franklin County Technical School District Committee.

B. A prospective **district student** must reside in one of the towns comprising the Franklin County Technical School District, as follows:

It is the responsibility of the prospective student to document residency eligibility as might be required. A resident is a person:

- a) Less than 18 years old and living within the District with parent(s), a legal guardian or in a foster home situation as a result of a specific court action or the action of a qualified social agency;
- b) Eighteen years of age or older residing within the District.

C. To be eligible for admission, a prospective student must have successfully completed grade 8 or beyond.

D. Admissions criteria involve a review of an applicant's academic performance, attendance and discipline. An interview by a Franklin County Technical School counselor is mandatory. If the applicant misses the scheduled interview at his/her sending school, **it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to schedule an interview with F.C.T.S.** Students interviewed after April 15th will be placed on a waiting list and considered for acceptance during the month of September.

E. **Non-district students** should apply by March 16th to ensure adequate time for superintendent notification.

Applicants are considered without regard to race, creed, color, gender, transgender, national origin, sexual orientation or disability, and have equal access to all technical programs.
